700 MHz Public Safety Debate Continues On April 13 With Economist On *WCA Live!*

WASHINGTON, DC (April 13, 2007) – The intensifying debate continues over best uses for spectrum in the 700 MHz with today’s edition of *WCA Live!* – the radio webcast produced by the [Wireless Communications Association International](http://www.wcai.com) (WCA). Hosts of the show are WCA President Andrew Kreig and *My Technology Lawyer Radio* Producer Scott Draughon.

Joining the show at 2 p.m. (Eastern) on Friday will be:

- Jeffrey A. Eisenach, Ph.D., Chairman, Criterion Economics
- Mark W. Pagon, Chairman & CEO, Pegasus Communications, which also sells services under the name Xanadoo
- Coleman Bazelon, Vice President, Analysis Group, Inc.

WCA Live! hosts will provide at the beginning of the show a live news summary of the week’s developments most important to broadband wireless throughout the world. Dr. Eisenach’s work includes a White Paper undertaken in cooperation with the Consumer Electronics Association and High Tech Coalition, and his blog analyzing Frontline. WCA’s March 2 show featured Frontline CTO Stagg Newman, Ph.D., former FCC chief technologist. This week’s discussion includes a plan proposed last June to the FCC by WCA members Pegasus, Access Spectrum and Intel Corp. along with Columbia Capital named “The Broadband Optimization Plan” that would reconfigure the spectrum in various ways. Among the alternative plans are a “Commercial 700 MHz Proposal” that would reorganize 16.5 MHz of paired spectrum into three 5.5 MHz blocks of paired spectrum. The options are displayed in the White Papers section of WCA’s new website for the association’s [700 MHz Committee](#). Dr. Bazelon joined Analysis Group to expand the firm’s telecommunications practice area. As additional background, FCC Chairman Kevin Martin this week circulated a draft order and further proposals on the agency’s 700 MHz auction rules, according to press and analyst reports. “We understand that although the draft contains few final decisions, it narrows the focus by offering concrete proposals on remaining key issues, and proposes a bandplan that permits continued consideration of the Frontline proposal,” Stifel, Nicolaus & Company said in a research note. Under the DTV law, the auction

of commercial spectrum must start by January 2008. The FCC is expected to vote on the item at its April 25 meeting.
